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Disabled Veteran Exemption Application Temporarily Excluded from Online Portal

FORT BEND COUNTY, TX –The Fort Bend Central Appraisal District’s (FBCAD) online exemptions application portal does not currently support the submission of form 50-135, Application for Disabled Veteran’s or Survivor’s Exemption.

Form 50-135 applies to partially disabled veterans or survivors of partially disabled veterans as determined by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. Form 50-114, Residence Homestead Exemption Application, which includes the option for the 100 percent disabled veterans’ exemption, is currently available via the online exemptions portal.

FBCAD apologizes for any inconvenience this may cause. We are working to get this added to the online portal as soon as possible. The application, however, can be still submitted in-person, by US mail, or to info@fbcad.org.
