Fort Bend Central Appraisal District Named a Top Houston Workplace In 2023

FORT BEND — The Fort Bend Central Appraisal District (**FBCAD**) has been selected as a Top Workplace in the Houston metropolitan area by the <u>Houston Chronicle</u> for the second year in a row.
